Introduction

The St. Monica Fr. Adolph Nadrach Knights of Columbus Council #12998 will award one \$1,000 scholarship to a graduating high school senior student who will be attending college, university, community college, or a trade school for the 2018/2019 school year. The student must be a practicing member of St. Monica Parish.

How to Apply

Interested students will need to fill out a scholarship application including contact information and the school that they will be attending in the Fall of 2018, if known at the time of applying. They will also need to provide examples of how they demonstrate in their lives the principles of the Knights of Columbus (Charity, Unity, Fraternity, Patriotism), how they foster a pro-life culture, and service. This is not a writing contest. There is no minimum GPA requirement.

Applications are to be filled out and delivered to the church office in an envelope marked "2018 K of C Scholarship." Applications can also be emailed to t_kcipich@yahoo.com. Applications are to be turned in no later than April 15, 2018.
