## Liturgy

### Lector

The lector recites the Scripture reading during the Mass according to the Liturgical Calendar.

### Altar Server

The Altar Servers are grades 4 and up. They assist the priest during Mass. They also assist the Sacristans before and after Mass.

### Sacristan

The Sacristans are in charge of the set up and return of everything after Mass. They also make sure there are enough volunteers during each Mass.

### Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion

Extraordinary Ministers assist the Priest during Mass with the distributions of the Blessed Sacrament.

### Usher

The Ushers assist members in finding a seat. They collect the Offerings at Mass. They also direct traffic during processions
