Instructions for Letter to the Bishop—PLEASE DO NOT MAIL YOUR LETTER TO THE BISHOP. If your letter does not follow the directions, you will be asked to rewrite it until it is correct.

Each candidate is to write a letter to the Bishop expressing his/her desire to receive the sacrament. Since the Bishop cannot be present in each parish to meet the candidates prior to the reception of the sacrament, the letters allow him to get to know something about the candidates and their preparation for the sacrament.

Please use the following format:
(Each number should be a paragraph in your letter).

1. Candidate should introduce him/herself. (family, school, activities, etc.)
2. Candidate should describe what he/she has done to prepare for the sacrament.
3. Candidate should tell the Bishop who his/her sponsor is and why he/she chose that person.
4. Candidate should ask to receive the sacrament, and explain why he/she desires to be confirmed. (e.g. I am writing to request the sacrament of Confirmation because...)
