

Confirmation Mass Dress Code
St. Monica Parish
2018 - 2019

General Rules for all Candidates and their Sponsors

Candidates should be dressed modestly
Candidates should wear their Sunday best
No tennis shoes or flip-flops
No visible tattoos
No body armor of any kind
No words or pictures should be visible on your clothing
Nothing should be low cut or transparent--tops or bottoms
No under garments should be visible

Girls

Girls should be in a dress, skirt, or dress pants
No chino pants or jeans
Girls should not wear spaghetti straps or strapless tops
Sleeveless dresses or tops should be at least the width of your fist
(If your spaghetti strap, strapless or sleeveless dress has already been purchased, it must be covered by a sweater)
Skirts must come to the knee or lower, no mini skirts, no shorts
Nothing low cut or backless
Girls are limited to 2 sets of earrings per ear—no other visible body armor
Girls must wear a bra that is not visible

Boys

Boys must wear dress or chino pants, black, brown, tan, blue or gray, only
No jeans
All shirts must have a collar and be tucked in
Boys should wear a belt, black or brown only
Ties and dress coats are both optional, but encouraged
No earrings or other visible body armor
Boys must wear black or brown dress shoes

All these policies pertain to both the Candidate and the Sponsor.
If a sponsor will not comply with this dress code, a parent will need to
step in for the sponsor before the Mass.

We reserve the right to correct any other forms of inappropriate dress on the day of the Mass, if necessary.
