1. Opening Prayer— **Prayer to the Holy Spirit**

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, enkindle in us the fire of Your love, send forth Your Spirit, and we shall be created, and You will renew the face of the Earth.

2. Question—Why is Confirmation important to us and society in general?  
Why do we bother with Confirmation? Isn't Baptism enough?

3. Information—

Some common misconceptions about the Sacrament of Confirmation are the ideas that Confirmation is an ending: we don't have to go to CCD class anymore; or that the sacrament can be earned.

Here are the facts: Confirmation is the beginning. You are choosing to follow Jesus. You are becoming a soldier for Christ and His Church: the Catholic Church. Your "armor" or protection is INFORMATION about Jesus and His church. Your job is to continue to learn and gain knowledge to help you spread the gospel and defend the beliefs of the Catholic Church.

Can we earn this sacrament? Every sacrament is a gift from God. There is nothing we can do to earn that gift as we are actually chosen by God. He gives it freely to each of us. We are called to learn about that gift, which is why we attend class. We are called to orient ourselves to the one giving the gift (God). We are called to be thankful that God loves us so much that He bestows on us the greatest gifts!

4. Discussion—How do I become a soldier? Sponsor gives examples from their personal experiences trying to be a soldier. Courage, knowledge, kindness.

5. Closing Prayer— **Anima Christi**

1. Opening Prayer—  
O, God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever enjoy His consolations, through Christ our Lord, Amen.
2. Questions—Why was I born? What is my purpose in life? Why the Catholic Church, and not another Christian church?
3. Information—Why were you born? According to the Baltimore Catechism, your sole purpose is to know God, to love God and to serve God and to be happy with Him in this life and the next.

All Christians, regardless of their denomination can get to Heaven, but the Catholic Church provides us with 3 very important things—

- A. The Most Direct Route—Do you want to go to Battle Creek down I-94 or via China? He gives us a guidebook, a road map, to follow with the precepts of the Catholic Church. The more we follow His rules and plan, the happier we become. His commandments are not about restricting us, they are about freeing us. Do we want our lives to be a path that is long, sorrowful, dangerous, and complicated? Why not go to heaven by the easiest route possible?
  - B. The Means to Follow the Direct Route--We are given all the graces of the Church through the sacraments. These graces make it possible for us to follow the precepts of the Church when others might say the “rules and regulations” are impossible to obey in today’s modern society. Without the grace of the sacraments, we humans could never follow the “guidebook”. We would, very simply, fail.
  - C. The only church started by Jesus Christ Himself—The Catholic Church was started by Christ Himself, not some guy with his own ideas. God did not start a church that needed updating over the centuries. He can foresee all. This is why He gave us such a perfect gift with the Catholic Church. We do not have a faith based on just the Bible. No, we have the perfect balance with the Bible, the catechism and the Magisterium. If you had a choice of a stool with one or three legs, which would you choose?
4. Discussion—Do you understand your purpose and it’s very real alternative? Do you really think God was so shortsighted as to not see our modern society and its changes over the centuries? Do you want a peace-filled life or not? Why wouldn’t you choose the better plan for yourself? How can Confirmation turn it into my success?
  5. Closing Prayer—Psalm 51; 12-  
Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me.

1. Opening Prayer—

**St. Augustine's Prayer to the Holy Spirit**

Strengthen me, O Holy Spirit, to defend all that is holy.

3. Information—Eucharist means Thanksgiving. We do not attend Mass for us, we attend Mass because we owe everything we have to God and he asks so little of us. He created us, knows and loves us better than anyone and is overjoyed when we visit Him.
